### Welcome WRTC-2010!








- It's a big privilege for Russian Amateur Radio Community to host WRTC-2010!

### QTH: Domodedovo



### **Location:**

- Domodedovo regional town with a population over 80,000 people.
- Near Domodedovo Intl. Airport
- 11 miles South from Moscow

### Typical climate data for July:

- Night temperature: +14°C (57F)
- Day temperature: +23°C (73F)



### QTH: Hotel




 WRTC competitors, referees and guests will stay at the Atlas Park Hotel, located near Domodedovo and within minutes from competition sites.







### QTH: WRTC-2010 Locations



- All operating sites are located within 40 x 30 km area with an elevation difference of less than 40 meters.
- Minimal distance 500 meters between each site.
- All teams brought to their sites early on Saturday morning, July 10, 8-9 hours before IARU contest begins.
- 2-3 volunteers at each site will take care of the power generator.

### QTH: Field Sites



- Domodedovo was the place of the Russian Radiosport Team Championship in 2007-09
- Each location is equipped with:
  - \* 20/15/10m tri-bander antenna, 40 m and 80 m Inverted V dipoles on 12m tower.
  - \* Power Generator.
  - \* Comfortable tent, tables, chairs, toilet cabin.
